### **Code of Conduct for Parents, Guardians, Carers and other Spectators**

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play within them
- Discourage unfair play and arguing with officials
- Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results
- Never force your child to take part in sport
- Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding the good performances of all
- Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes
- Publicly accept officials' judgements
- Support your child's involvement and help them enjoy their sport

### **Code of Conduct for Children**

#### **I will:**

- **Try to** have fun and encourage other participants in a positive manner
- Try hard to keep safe and encourage others to play safely and responsibly
- Do my best to treat everyone with respect and value other people's help
- Use equipment for the purpose for which it is intended
- Listen carefully to those who coach me and act as directed
- Be a good sportsman, act fairly and never deliberately cheat
- Ensure that I wear the proper clothing and take plenty of refreshments

#### **I will not:**

- Bully or laugh at other participants either by myself or as part of a group
- Keep quiet about bullying that I see or anything that could make another sports person unhappy
- Swear at, argue with or insult the coaches, officials or other participants
- Smoke, consume alcohol or drugs of any kind
- Disrupt any sessions or activities

#### **Bullying can be:**

- **Physical:** pushing, hitting, kicking, pinching, etc,
- **Verbal:** name-calling, spreading rumours, constant teasing and sarcasm,
- **Emotional:** tormenting, ridiculing, humiliating and ignoring,
- **Racial:** taunts, graffiti and gestures,
- **Sexual:** unwanted physical contact or abuse
- **Electronically:** unwelcome texting, e-mails and blogs
