The Council has been reviewing its planning policies and with your help over the last few years has put together a new generation of planning policies which guide development in the future and which set out the broad locations for new housing, jobs and community facilities. These new policies are explained in a document called the Draft Core Strategy 2.

What is the major issue facing Bromsgrove?

The District has identified that up to 2021, at least 4000 new homes are required to meet Bromsgrove's housing needs with the potential for an additional 2-3000 new homes after 2021. This plan also sets out proposals

for how land for jobs should be provided.

What is your neighbourhood?

We would also like you to tell us what you feel is your neighbourhood. Is it your street, your ward, your Parish, Bromsgrove as a whole or something else? We will then use this information to help us to work with you in better ways in the future.

Have we got it right?

This Draft Area Action Plan specifically covers the Town Centre. It sets out the issues at present and identifies a number of proposals which we think will help improve the Town Centre. This is the second draft of the AAP, in July 2008 the Council published an Issues and Options version which highlighted issues which the Council felt it needs to address to ensure long term success and regeneration of the Town Centre. Many responses were received to the first consultation and these have been used in preparing this Draft AAP.

Have we got it right?

In response to the previous consultation the Town Centre Draft AAP now contains a number of detailed strategies to guide the overall regeneration of the Town and specific development proposals for key sites. We would therefore like you to have your say on this plan and would welcome any views on the strategies and proposed development opportunities identified.
