

LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT IN HEALTH ACT 2007

The Bromsgrove District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance: Lickey End) Order 2011

Made 17th December 2010

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

Bromsgrove District Council ("the Council") in accordance with section 82 of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 ("the 2007 Act"), has undertaken a community governance review and made recommendations dated 2010.

The Council has decided to give effect to those recommendations and, in accordance with section 93 of the 2007 Act, has consulted with local government electors and other interested persons and has had regard to the need to secure that community governance reflects the identities and interests of the community and is effective and convenient:

The Council in accordance with section 100 of the 2007 Act, has had regard to guidance issued under that section;

The Council makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 86 and 240(10) of the 2007 Act.

1. Citation and commencement

1.1 This order may be cited as the Bromsgrove District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance: Lickey End) Order 2011.

1.2 It shall come into force on 01 January 2011.

2. Interpretation

In this Order:-

"District" means the District of Bromsgrove

"map" means the map marked "Map referred to in the Bromsgrove District Council (Reorganisation of Community Governance: Lickey End) Order 2011 and deposited in accordance with section 96(4) of the 2007 Act;

"registration officer" means an officer appointed for the purpose of, and in accordance with, Section 8 of the Representation of the People Act 1983.

3. Effect of the Order

This Order has effect subject to any agreement under section 99 (agreements about incidental matters) of the Local Government and Public Involvement in Health Act 2007 relevant to the provision of this Order.

4. Dissolution of parish council for the parish of Lickey End

The parish council for the parish of Lickey End shall be dissolved.

5. Abolition of the parish of Lickey End

The parish of Lickey End shall be abolished


6. Electoral register

The registration officer for the District of Bromsgrove shall make such re-arrangement of, or adaptation of, the register of local government electors as may be necessary for the purposes of, and in consequence of, this Order.

7. Order date

01 January 2011 is the order date for the purposes of the Local Government (Parishes and Parish Councils)(England) Regulations 2008.

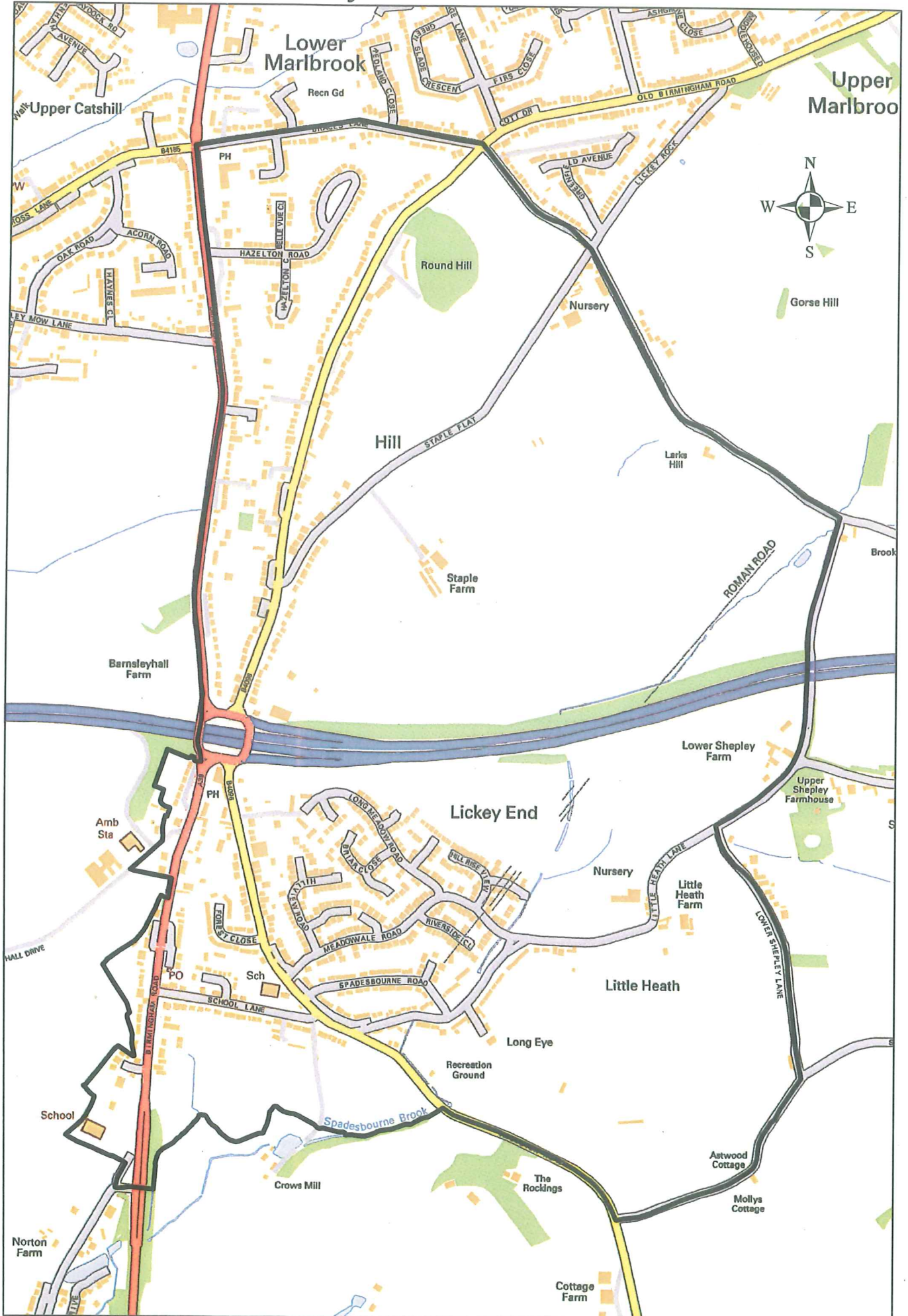

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order gives effect to recommendations made by Bromsgrove District Council for the abolition of the parish of Lickey End and the dissolution of the council for the parish of Lickey End

The parish of Lickey End will be abolished with effect from 01 January 2011. The Council for the parish of Lickey End will be dissolved from 01 January 2011.

Article 6 obliges the Electoral Registration Officer to make any necessary amendments to the electoral register to reflect the new electoral arrangements.

The map defined in article 2 shows edged in black the area of the parish of Lickey End affected by this Order. It is available for inspection during office hours at the offices of Bromsgrove District Council, The Council House, Burcot Lane, Bromsgrove.
