# **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

The New Traders Scheme offers traders their first four consecutive trading weeks at 50% rents.

- The scheme only operates from January to November.
- All traders attending in December will be liable to pay full rents.
- All days/weeks booked under this scheme are to be taken before 1<sup>st</sup> Dec; any days/weeks remaining after this date can only be used from January.
- The scheme runs for 4 consecutive weeks only. No days or weeks are transferable.
- The scheme is nontransferable to any another trader.
- All applicants must be selling new or under represented lines and no change of goods is permitted without written authorization - Please enquire with the market manager who will check with the balance of trade policy.
- Traders applying under this scheme must on application submit payment for the first 4 discounted rents, the fee being dependent on the days the trader wishes to attend.
- No Fees are returnable should a trader wishes to terminate their attendance.
- Following conclusion of the scheme traders will have the option to become a regular trader, if space is available.
- No regular pitch is guaranteed and the council through the market manager, reserves the right to allocate a different pitch on any trading day.
- The Market Managers decision on all matters arising from the T&C's is final.

## **Public Liability Insurance Requirements**

- For the first week, no insurance is required however for subsequent weeks thereafter traders will need to provide a public liability certificate of £5million indemnity.

## **SUPPLIMENTARY CHARGES**

The following charge is not discounted.

- The use of any electrical supply (per socket) £3.10 per day or £9.20 per week.

## **General Data Protection Regulations Bromsgrove Market**

Bromsgrove District Council collects personal information about you for the fulfilment of a contract, or to take steps to enter into a contract; by signing up to apply to trade on Bromsgrove Market, you are entering into a contract, and we require the personal data requested to fulfil this contract.

Data collected is:

- (ID will be requested but not retained)

This information will be refreshed annually.

When you enter into the contract, you can opt to consent to us processing your personal information for other specified purposes such as:

- Subscribing to the survey to inform the development of the market.
- Taking Images at events for promoting the market via the website, e-newsletter and social media.
- Taking video footage at events for promoting the market via the website, e-newsletter and social media.

Where you agree to be contacted, the data will be kept until it is either overwritten or until you no longer agree to be kept informed. If you chose not to consent to additional processing, this will not affect your or your rights.
