<b>Casual and Seasonal Traders (December)</b>		
Tuesday, Friday and Saturday	£5.75 extra charge on top of a casual fee - this is reimbursed when the trader attends in January. This prevents the cherry picking of seasonal markets and encourages the market to remain full during the quiet months of January and February.	
<b>Market Hire</b>		
Full market with 3 staff	£757.05	Based on a full standard market inc wear & tear and 3 staff working 6hrs each with oncost
<b>Trader Incentive Scheme</b>		
New Traders will be charged 50% rent (based on the casual fee for that day) for 4 continous weeks only between January and November
