

Bromsgrove District Council - Community Survey 2023

This survey was opened on Friday 13 October 2023; an invite was sent directly to all members of the Community Panel. The survey remained open for 4 full weeks. Two reminder was sent to panel members. A total of 196 valid surveys were returned from the panel, resulting in a response rate of 44%. The survey was publicised in local media and numerous times on social media during the 4 weeks. A total of 459 surveys were received from the general public resulting in a final figure of 655 completed surveys for analysis.

A total of 1,169 people interacted with the survey. 655 were fully completed and 227 were partially completed. The remaining 287 opened the survey but didn't answer any of the questions. The results of the completed surveys are shown in the table below.

Some results may appear significantly different when compared with previous years. Whilst this might be a true reflection, it needs to be borne in mind that since 23 March 2020 there have been significant changes to peoples' lives due to the Covid-19 pandemic.
