

Bromsgrove District Council - Places Survey 2025

This survey is largely based on the Places Survey which ran during August and September 2024. A direct invite was sent directly to all members of the Community Panel and links were sent to partners to share with their contacts and the survey was publicised in local media and numerous times on social media. This survey was open between 14 October 2025 and the 9 November 2025. A total of 176 valid surveys were returned from the panel, resulting in a response rate of 40%. A total of 174 surveys were received from the general public. The final figure of 350 completed surveys for analysis.
